ILONA (ILLY) BELL

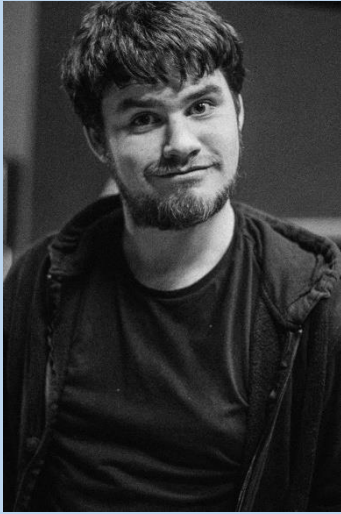

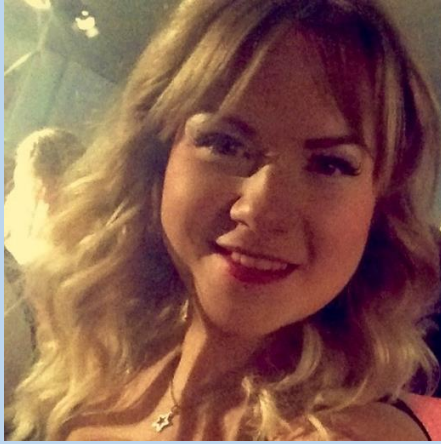
Favourite memory: Probably when I had to perform with a cast on and say the line 'all you have to do is stand up, and walk away', that or performing Blood Wedding.

KATE TAYLOR



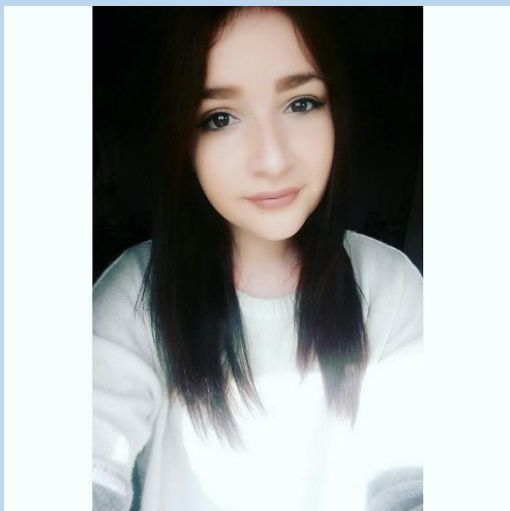

MAISHA VARSANI

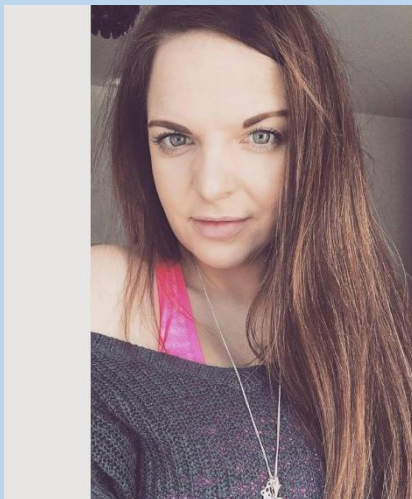

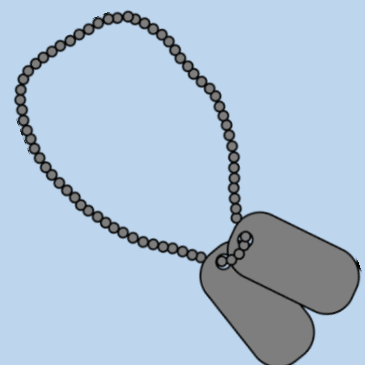
